GUIDELINES

COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT

Measures present or most recent involvement in assisting or developing programs or services beneficial to the interests of the community.

SERVICE (ABOVE SELF)

Participates in projects, services, events that benefit the community that are not self-servicing.

ETHICS

Measures the honest and ethical practices to achieve the desired results.

LENGTH OF COMMUNITY SERVICE

Measures the dedicated time committed to improving the community and improving the quality of life for our residents.

INNOVATION

Measures the innovation for ideas, programs, and services, either enacted or projected.

LEADERSHIP

Measures the person's/organization's command and control of programs or projects, meeting deadlines, inspiring others, and ability to gain support.

RULE SEVEN

A catchall for unlisted activities or abilities that merit consideration in the overall selection process.
